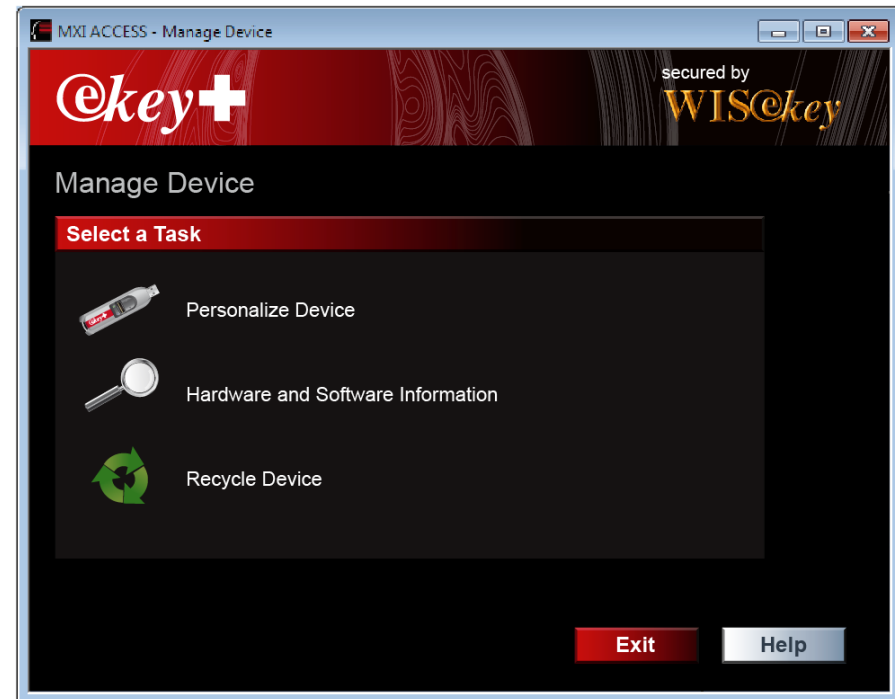

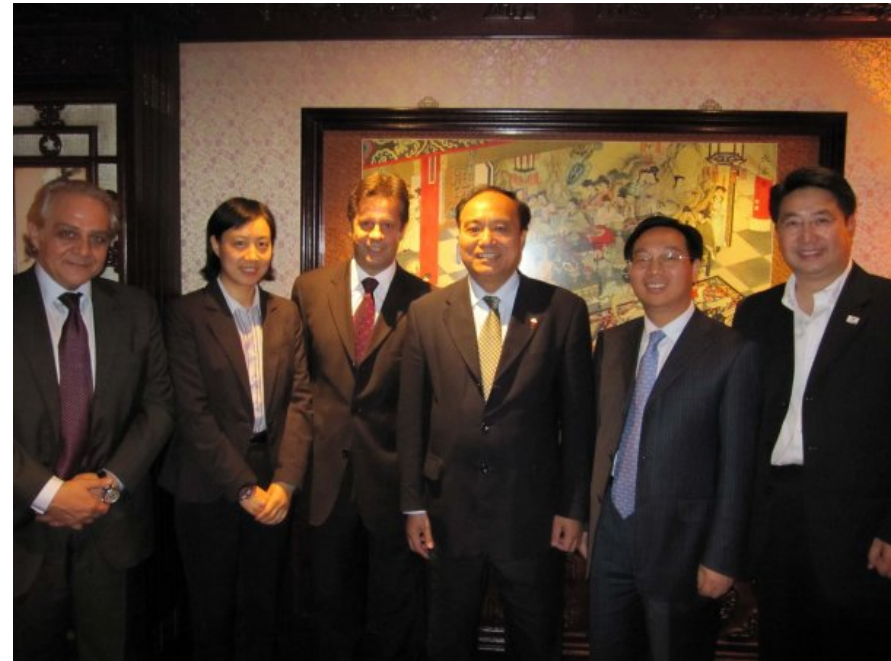


GSF Cybersecurity Forum at Telecom 2009

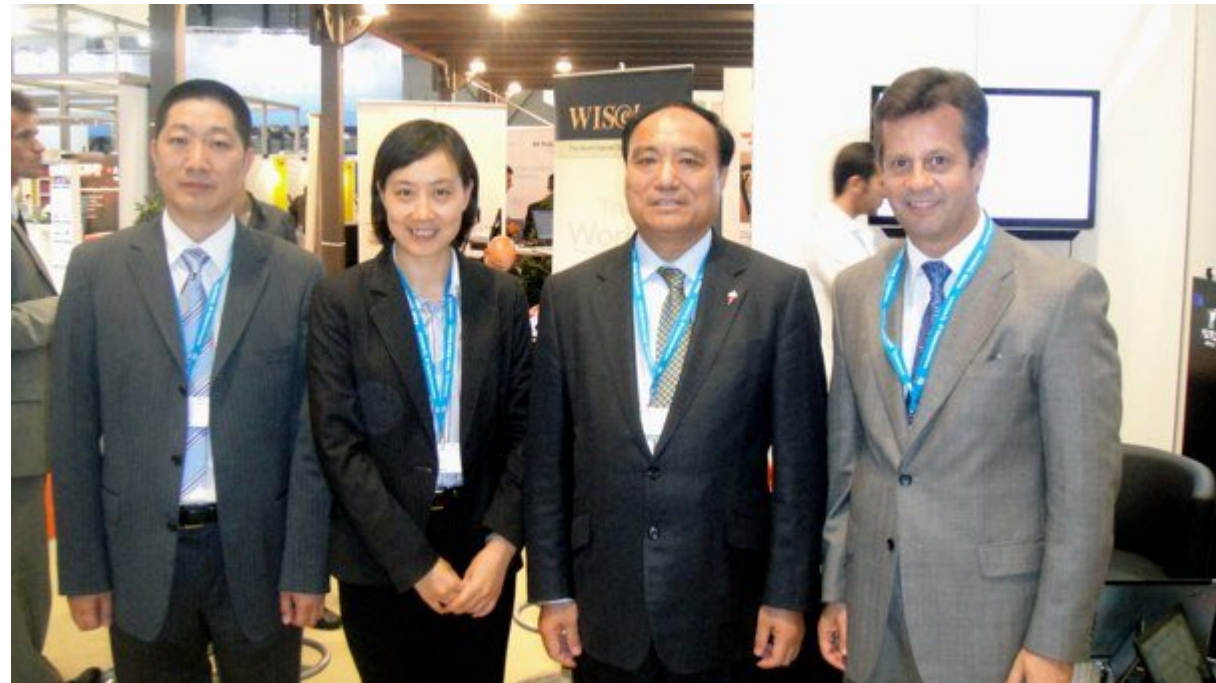
